Holi Celebration

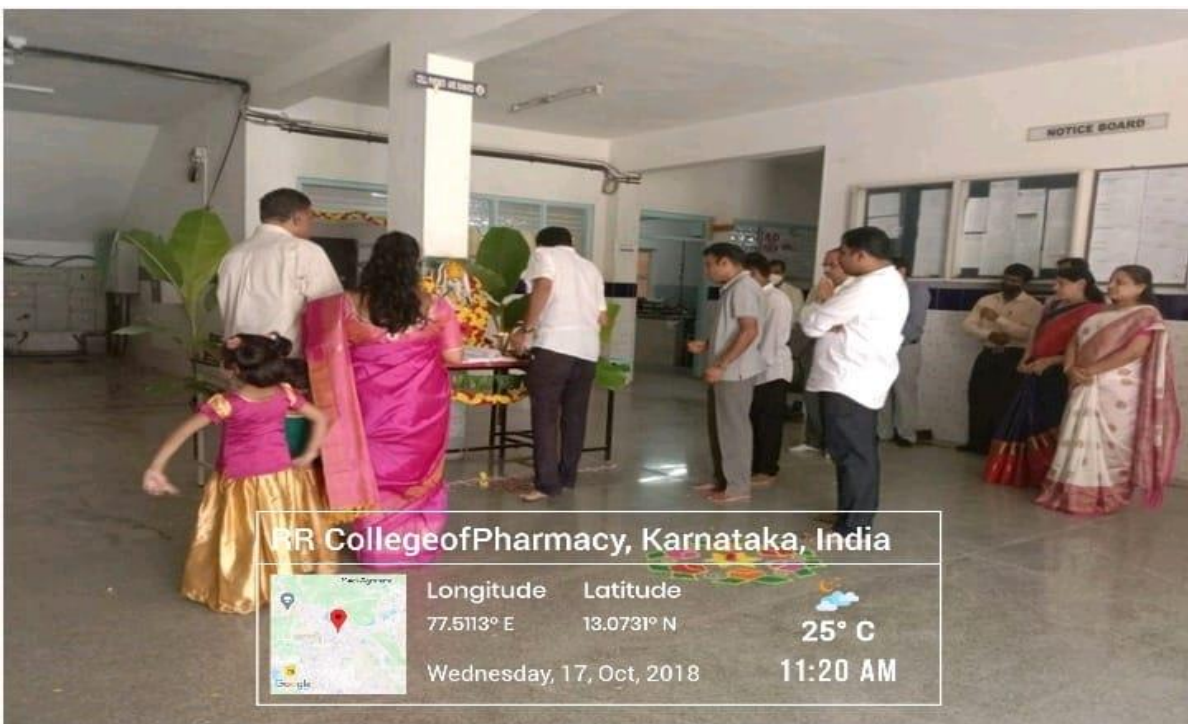

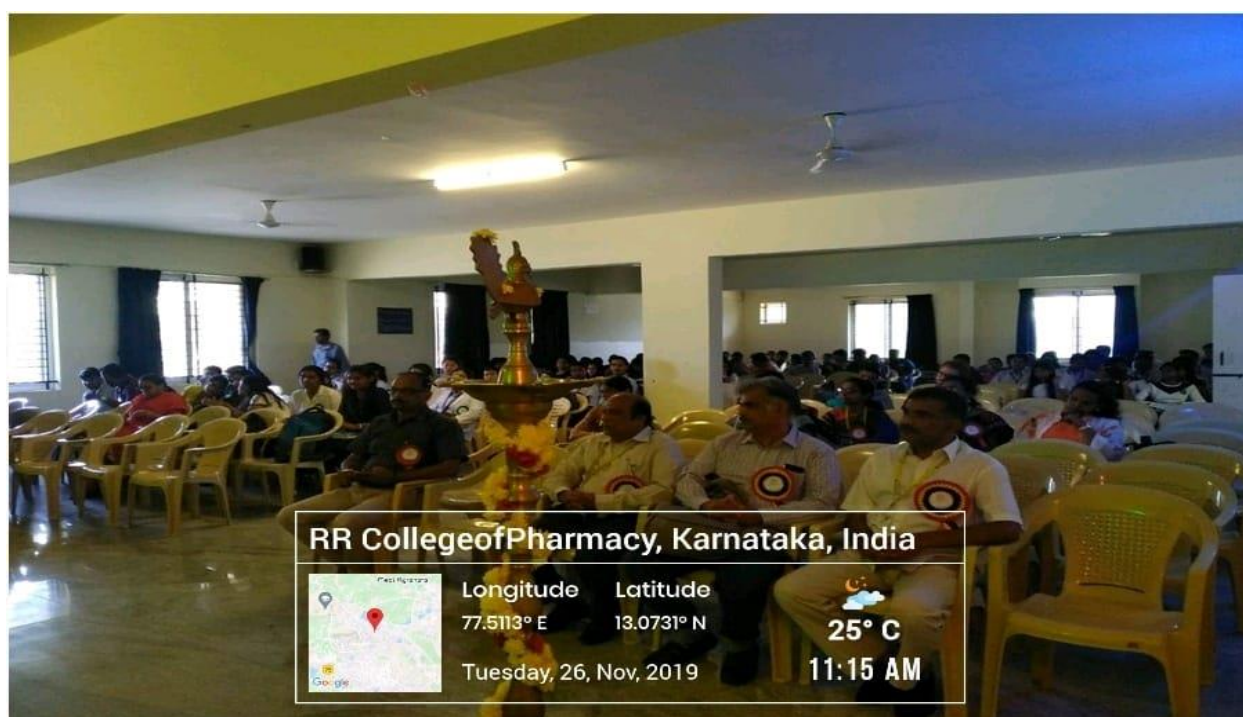






Constitution day- (26th November)

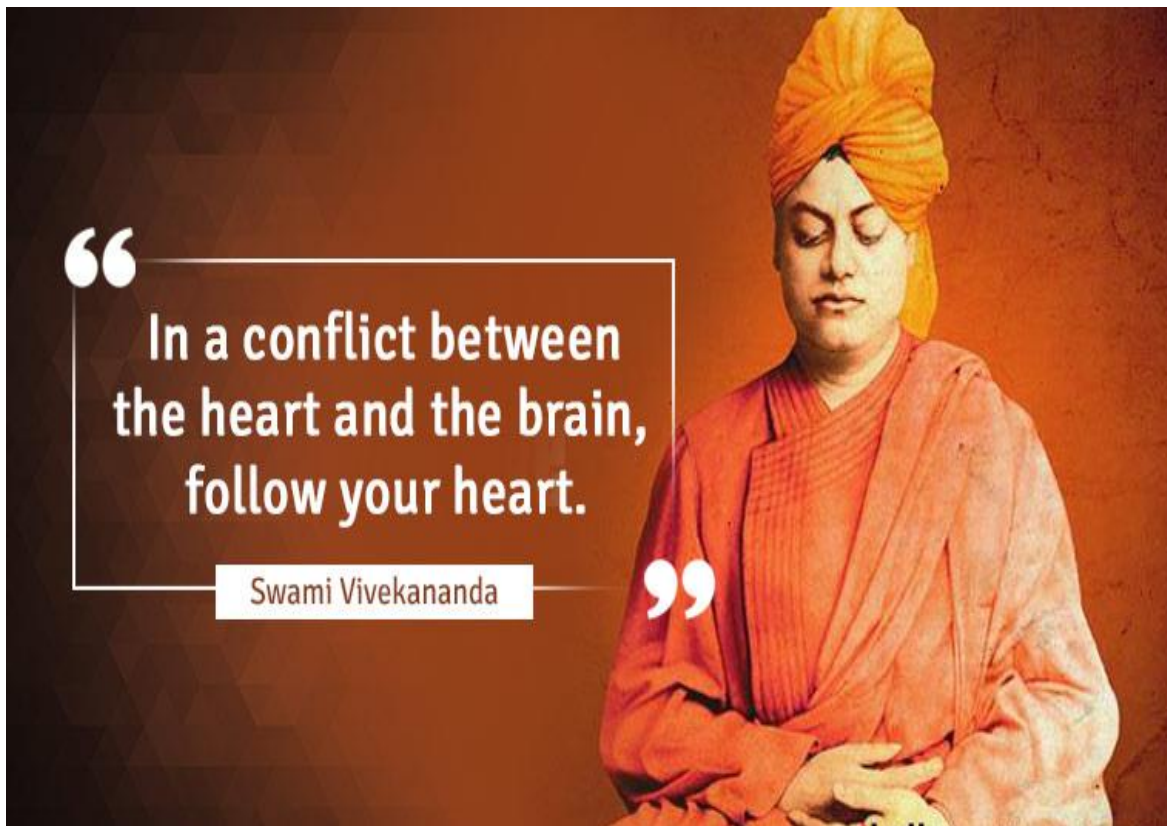


National Youth Day:
