






A Seminar on "possible consequences of sexual harassment" by Mrs.Sujata M. RRCOP was held on 6th october2023

Points covered were as follows:

We are firm believers that we need to help break the silence, raise awareness and change
negative social norms surrounding so that women and girls feel empowered to manage
their work safely, confidence and without embarrassment

Sexual harassment at work is prohibited as a type of gender discrimination under both the antidiscrimination laws of New Jersey and of the federal government. If sexual harassment is reported, the harasser can suffer a number of consequences such as

Liability: If an employer is aware of the harassment and does not act to prevent or stop it, they can be held legally accountable. This can lead to the company paying substantial fines or settlements.

Reputation Damage: In the era of social media and instant news, a company's reputation can be tarnished overnight. News of mishandling a sexual harassment case can lead to loss of customers, partners, and potential top-tier talent.

Decreased Productivity: A hostile work environment can reduce overall productivity, with employees feeling unsafe or demotivated to work efficiently. When victims of sexual harassment report what happened to them, they may face consequences despite the fact that retaliation is illegal. These consequences might include the following:

- Retaliation: Victims might face undue repercussions such as unjustified termination, demotion, or salary reductions.
- Workplace Alienation: Victims might feel isolated from their peers, leading to emotional and psychological distress.
